Use the Daily Disaster Dashboard

All disasters are location-specific

A hurricane might devastate a coastline.

A wildfire might threaten a community.

A pandemic might shut down a nation or even the entire world.

But to respond to a disaster effectively you need to know:

- *What area is impacted?*
- *Where are the resources that are needed to respond to it?*
- *What roads are open to get the resources to where they are needed?*

These questions and many others require accurate, timely data about the weather, infrastructure, availability of power and other vital factors. Because all this data is location based, SEEING it on a map is better than trying to understand data in spreadsheets, or documents.

The All Hazards Consortium (AHC) and its Sensitive Information Sharing Environment (SISE) Working Group created the Daily Disaster Dashboard which is powered by GeoCollaborate. The Daily Disaster Dashboard enables public and private sector decision-makers to coordinate their response efforts. The Daily Disaster Dashboard fuses many different types of data into a simple visual tool for faster response and recovery.

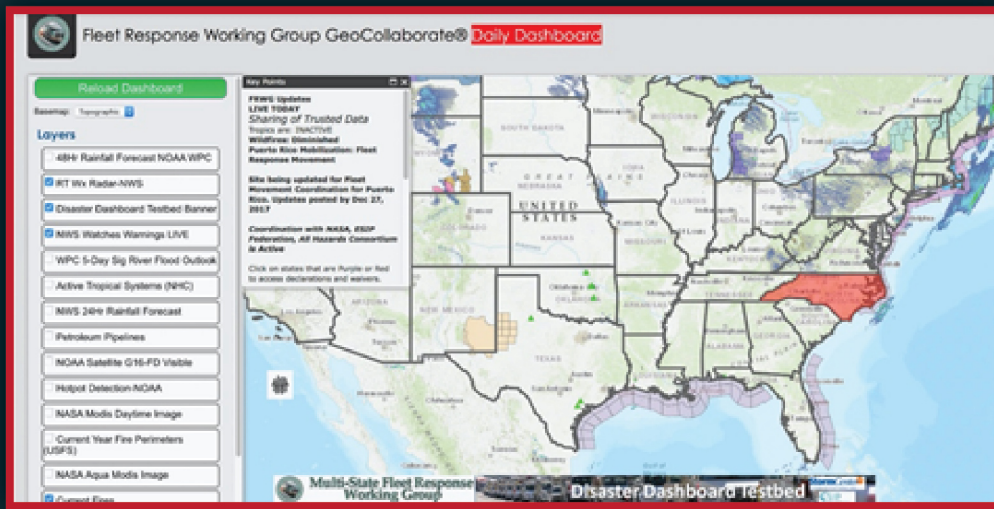

THE INFORMATION YOU NEED TO GET BACK TO BUSINESS

The Daily Disaster Dashboard empowers you to choose the data that is most relevant to your organization's response and recovery. Among the free and optional premium data sets available are:

Geographic Region of Interest

Zoom in or out to see the the relevant data for your operational area. View your city, state, region, or the entire country.

Weather

Up-to-date and highly accurate storm data is displayed on the Daily Disaster Dashboard. Severe storm tracks showing paths are displayed. Watches, warnings and advisories. Flood maps and coastal surge projections.

Critical Infrastructure

Power outages, road and bridge closures, and other impacted critical infrastructure status. Traffic congestion and airport delays and closures.

Open/Closed Commercial Facilities

Availability of fuel, food, lodging, resources, and other essential items in and around the impacted area.

Government Declarations

Road restrictions, waivers and other documents for both dark-sky and blue-sky states. Stay at home orders during pandemics and other government orders that can impact logistics and travel.

Critical Resources and Supplies

Location-specific data on suppliers of generators, equipment, lighting, refrigeration, contractors, and other response and recovery resources and services.

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
