TRUST

Without trust there can be no cooperation. But getting public and private sector stakeholders to trust each other isn't easy.

Since 2005, the All Hazards Consortium (AHC) has worked to bring disparate sets of disaster response and critical infrastructure stakeholders together. These efforts led to the creation of the SISE.

The SISE is a legal **"trust framework"** that supports sensitive operational information sharing across industry and government for the purpose of enhancing decision making before, during and after storms, disasters or any type of disruptions.

VETTED USERS

The SISE uses a sophisticated process of identity vetting and verification and users are segmented into categories and subcategories that allow data providers to know who is looking at their information, for what purpose, and for how long they will have access.

There are currently over 1,000 registered users of the SISE nationwide. They come from all states and sectors in the U.S.

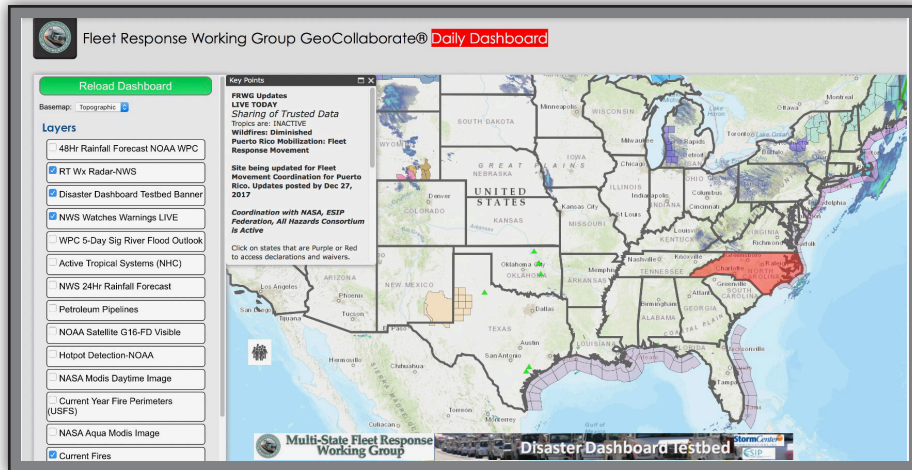
Benefits of the SISE

Disaster Test and Proven

The value of the SISE was tested and proven in 2017 with hurricanes, Harvey, Irma, and Maria.

The SISE developed the private sector operated Regional Common Operating Picture (RCOP), also known as the Daily Dashboard. This platform allowed the private sector to coordinate more effectively with multiple states and federal agencies during a multi-state disaster.



The Daily Dashboard has large operational impacts on business continuity, supply chain recovery, restoration, and overall infrastructure resilience.
